Christian Aid's commitment to you

Welcome to the Partnership Scheme!

Christian Aid has a contract with the European Commission for the funding of the project you are supporting. The effect of this is that for every £1 your group gives to the project, they will match it by at least £3, multiplying your group's gifts. This is only available for a limited number of projects.

Because of the extra financial administration involved in the scheme, we can only accept donations by cheque (ideally a minimum of £500 at a time), posted to the London address you will be given with your paying-in slips. Please use the gift aid scheme if you can as this will further increase the value of individuals' donations. If you can make the gift aid reclaim yourselves (eg via your church) and send us the total, then this can be used for the scheme. However, if you need Christian Aid to make the reclaims, the money would instead go to our work around the world (still valuable of course, but this cannot be tracked and allocated to your partnership scheme target).

Christian Aid has ongoing commitments to many projects around the world. 10% of the money you raise for the scheme will be given to our other projects around the world and we hope you understand the reasons behind this. We would also be grateful if you could avoid diverting money from other fundraising for Christian Aid to the scheme. This is because we have so many projects that depend on the 'unrestricted' money that is given to Christian Aid throughout the year. Please continue to support them while you are taking on this new (and, we hope!) exciting challenge of supporting a particular project through our Partnership Scheme.
