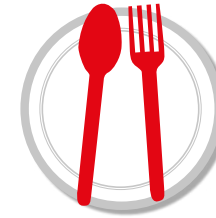


## Grace

# Harvest Supper

### India's excluded communities

In India's southern state of Tamil Nadu, around 20% of people are from the Dalit community. Many other people think they are superior to Dalits. They don't want to talk to them. They don't let them live in the same area. They don't think it's important to respect their rights. Sometimes, people are even violent to them.

The EcoVeg project is run by Christian Aid's partner ADISIL. It helps people from excluded communities with training in natural farming methods, as well as business and planning.

So far, EcoVeg has reached nearly 5,000 farmers. Over one-third are from excluded communities; 47% are women.
